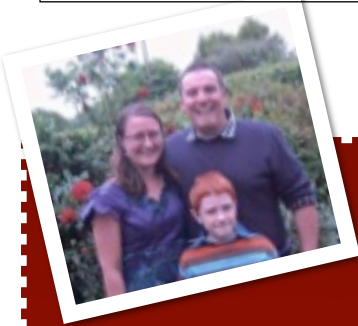

## *The Word brings Life & Freedom*

Some times my brain get tired, especially if I have done too much thinking. I am not in any way a linguist and so my brain has to work hard when folks around the office are sharing about some of the translation challenges they are facing. I am very curious about how they resolve those issues but I do often feel tired after one discussion and these translation colleagues of ours are doing that day in and day out. When all is done and those issues have been resolved and the translated scriptures are presented to

the language community, it is one almighty party! For so many people in that community, this is the start of a life changing interaction with God's Word. Recently the Cishingini language community from Kambari had a dedication ceremony for their newly printed New Testaments. These are some of the exciting things that people said.



“Before the dedication many were coming asking when are you going to make the Cishingini Bible ready for us? We want to read, to see and hear the word of God in our Language.”

When it was time to present the Kambari orthography and scriptural reading in the language the unbelievers, especial the Kambari Muslims were amazed to hear the Bible read in the language. One said, “It is wonderful and amazing to be reading in the language if Islam can make things like this we will have better understanding of things, that is why the Christian have better understanding of their religion.”

This year in Nigeria, 19 language communities will be able to read the Christmas story for the first time!

### **OUR PART**

With 120 ongoing projects and over 250 that still need starting, there are plenty of jobs that need doing. Ali is looking into stopping teaching at the school so she can concentrate on supporting all those language communities via data services, including archiving. Tim will continue to serve the director of Nigeria Group doing projects for him and being responsible for project funding. Dan is doing well at school academically and seems to have settled socially, we really appreciate his current teacher.
